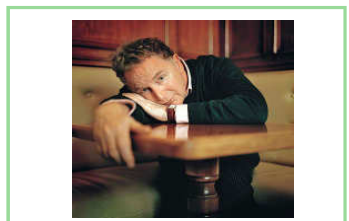
HSE ROOF WORKER SEMINAR : 11th MAY IN STOKE ON TRENT
